Introduction

Congratulations on your purchase of the **WisDom** - RISCO Group's Wireless Security System. The WisDom has been specifically designed to meet a wide range of security needs for many residential and small commercial applications. To make the most of your system we advise you to take some time to read through this easy user guide and also the accompanying user manual.

Wireless Devices

To ease your installation, all devices have already been pre-programmed into the system. The ID of each device is marked with a sticker on the device plastic and on the package. Devices in the kit include:

3 Magnetic Contacts

- Defined as zones 1,2 and 4
- Default application:

Zone 1 :Front door (Exit/entry)

Zone 2: Back door (Instant)

Zone 4: Garage door (Exit/entry)





Note: Remove the batteries from their plastic insulation. Replace them into the battery compartment and fit the lid.

1 PIR/Pet Detector

- Defined as Zone 3
- Default application: Living room.
- Zone type: Interior + Entry Follower

2 Wireless Key Fobs



Note: The buttons on the wireless key fob are sensitive to avoid false alarms, please handle the fobs with care

Full Arming (Leaving the Premises)





Press 8

Panic Alarm







Press small blank button

Home Arming (Arming while remaining inside))

Edit User Codes (Adding, changing or deleting a user code)

- 1. Press [*] [5] [Grand Master Code][* [1][1]
- 2. Enter a two digit USER ID number (00 to 32), then press

Note: Grand Master code is always (00) user ID.

- 3. Enter a code number for this chosen user and press **Note**: A code of '0' (zero) will delete the existing code.
- 4. Press * * * to return to normal display.

1. Press [*] [2] [2] [1] [Grand Master code][*)

2. Enter information according to display messages

Remote Phone Operation

Receiving a call from the system

- 1. Pick up the phone and say "Hello". You will hear an event announcement message.
- 2. Choose an option from the **Acknowledge** menu:

Acknowledge message	[1]	
Acknowledge and stop all dialling	[2] [User Code] [#]	
Access Operations menu (if defined)	[3] [User Code] [#]	
Access Operations menu (if defined)	[3] [User Code] [#]	
Listen In (if defined)	[6] [1]	
Talk (if defined) –	[6] [2]	
Repeat the event message	[#]	
Repeat the Acknowledge menu	[*]	

Calling the system

1. Dial the number of the premises

If an answering machine is present at the premises: Let the line ring once, hang up and call again.

If an answering machine is not in use at the premises:

Wait until the system picks up. You will hear a consecutive tone.

- 2. Enter the 2 digit remote access code.
- 3. Enter your user code followed by ***
- 4. Choose an option from the **Operations** menu:

Arming all partitions [1][1]

Arming by partition [1][9] [PARTITION NO.]

Arming all partitions [2][2]

Disarming by partition [2] 9][PARTITION NO.]
Changing zone Bypass [3][ZONE NO.][#][9]
